

## A new R&D project for Nordmeccanica

Piacenza, northern Italy - Nordmeccanica is the world's leading manufacturer of machines that produce bags for packaged food products, plastic packaging and pharmaceutical blisters, with a global market share of 65% and exports amounting to 95% of its overall turnover. The Company has five production plants, three in Italy (Piacenza), one in China (Shanghai) and one in the United States (New York), and a network of representatives covering 87 countries. The Group has 300 direct employees, and turnover of 110 million Euros, with R&D investments amounting to 15% of revenue.

*“In partnership with the University of Parma and a select group of qualified technical partners, we have started up a Remopack R&D project,”* - explains company president Antonio Cerciello. *“This will require significant investment over the next three years. The project has won a grant from the Italian Ministry of Economic Development, with its goal to develop a single-material high-barrier flexible packaging structure which is completely recyclable.”*
